CHANGING LIVES

Eligibility Requirements

1. You must be a Hamilton County Resident.
2. Be 18 years of age or older.
3. Have a direct, lived experience with mental health challenges.
4. Be actively engaged in your recovery.

Steps to Membership

Step One: Call us to schedule a tour of our organization at 513-241-1411. Once that is scheduled join us for your tour!

Step Two: After the tour, if you feel RCHC is the right fit for you and you meet our eligibility requirements, call us to schedule the intake.

Step Three: Join us for your intake appointment where we will assess if you meet the eligibility to be a member.
